PhD-candidates in Managerial Accounting

The Institute of Accounting (Institut für Unternehmensrechnung und Controlling - IUC), Managerial Accounting Section (Prof. Dr. Markus C. Arnold) at the University of Bern invites applications for post-doctoral research fellows and PhD candidates in Managerial Accounting.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants should have earned or be close to earning a master degree in Accounting or a related field (Management, Finance, Economics, Economic Psychology) at the start of the employment. All areas of accounting will be considered, but preference will be given to candidates with research interests related to managerial accounting. Expectations include strong quantitative skills either in applied game theory, experimental research methods, or social psychology. Knowledge in agency theory and institutional economics and the willingness to conduct experimental research are desired. A commitment to high-quality research and the propensity to interact with master students is indispensable. An excellent command of English in writing and oral presentations is necessary; a good command of the German language is welcome. Salary is very competitive and depends on the candidate's qualification. Starting date: as agreed upon.

PHD-PROGRAM:

Successful applicants become part of the recently founded Swiss Doctoral Program Network in Accounting Research (DAR-CH) jointly organized by the Universities of Basel, Bern, Neuchâtel and Zurich (see <http://www.dar.uzh.ch/courses.html>). The network universities provide their PhD-students with the opportunity to participate in doctoral courses offered by the four universities and their network partners. The courses are taught by renowned professors of leading U.S. and European universities and faculty members of the participating institutions. The program offers several possibilities for international mobility and network building within the academic accounting community. Successful PhD-students can expect to be well prepared for an academic career or for other qualified expert positions in the area of accounting.
