Applicants should hold an excellent master's degree specializing in accounting, economics or finance. In addition, the position requires advanced writing and communication skills in English. The position also involves teaching and research assistance. To this end, a fluent command of the German language is an advantage but not necessary. The position offers attractive working conditions including a competitive salary.

Successful candidates will become part of the Swiss Doctoral Program Network in Accounting Research (DAR-CH), jointly organized by the Universities of Basel, Bern, Neuchâtel and Zurich. DAR-CH offers a highly competitive doctoral study program that provides its participants with the relevant knowledge and skills to conduct scholarly accounting research. Courses are held by faculty members from the participating institutions as well as renowned professors from leading universities in the U.S. and Europe.
